

2023 SPRING RETREAT DEPARTURE & ARRIVAL INFORMATION:

DEPARTURE: Please arrive at Cornerstone (youth room) by 12pm on Friday, March 31st

***Please eat before you come and pack a snack. Dinner will not be until 5:30pm.*

ARRIVAL: We will return to Cornerstone at approximately 12pm on Sunday, April 2nd

Please understand that we do our best to keep on schedule, however traffic can affect our arrival time.

***Transportation is provided for the youth to and from camp, however if you would like to drop off or pick up your student at camp cedar crest, please let Pastor Scott or Cyndi know in advance so we can plan accordingly.*

CAMP RULES & PACKING INFORMATION:

We have five simple rules that we all live by at Camp to make sure that camps are fun, safe and a great experience for everyone!

1. **Be where you're supposed to be when you're supposed to be there.**

All meals, meetings and activities are mandatory. Campers must stay within the camp boundaries at all times.

2. **Respect other people and their belongings.**

Fighting, hazing, harassing or using foul language is NEVER permitted. Campers are automatically sent home for stealing or "raiding" (raiding is disrupting or damaging someone's belongings).

3. **No illegal stuff.**

All articles listed in the leave at home section must NOT be brought to camp!

4. **No guys in or around girls' space and no girls in or around guy's space.**

5. **You break it you bought it.**

All damages to camp property must be paid for prior to leaving camp. Camp imposes a \$500 fine for graffiti.

These rules are important and we take them seriously! Anyone who breaks them may be sent home early from camp. Parents are responsible for the transportation of students who are sent home.

Be Sure to Bring to Camp

- Bible & notebook & pens
- Sleeping bag (put in a plastic bag and label with your name, your church name) & pillow
- Clothes for the amount of days/nights. It is cold at night so pack layers. If snow is forecasted pack accordingly.
- Towel
- Chapstick / lip balm
- Flashlight
- Spending money (for snack shop)
- Toiletries: Shampoo, Toothbrush etc.
- Refillable Water Bottle
 - **VERY IMPORTANT!!!** Dehydration is the #1 sickness at camp!

Be Sure to Leave at Home

- Electronics (laser pointers, CD players, iPods, MP3 players, laptops, etc. Phones are allowed but will be confiscated if they become a distraction.
- Cigarettes, lighters & matches
- Alcohol & drugs
- Weapons of any kind
- Fireworks
- **Cell phones should be used minimally. And will be confiscated if seen in use during any activities or services etc.**
