Dinner Attire

At kids camp, we will be having themes at each of our dinner meals. We ask each camper to participate by dressing appropriately for each evening’s dinner.

Please, no expensive items.

Funky Formal – Wear anything old formal (like old prom dresses, old flower girl dresses, anything funky, big black bow tie and over sized shirts, etc.). Or even get a tie and blazer and wear them with those plaid slacks that dad thinks will some day come back into style. It does not matter if it fits.

GLOW (NEON)— Wear anything that is soooo bright that you need sunglasses just to look at you! Neon Green Glasses, Neon Pink Top, Neon Yellow Shorts...Let those colors GLOW!!!

Please be sure your child has had a good lunch before coming to camp. Our first meal together as a camp will be dinner on Friday night at 5pm.

Phone Policy-

There are phones, but they are only for emergencies! If a problem or an emergency occurs, one of our directing staff will call immediately.

No cell phones are allowed for campers.

If you have an emergency, call your church office and they will contact the camp.

Please no visitors – it is disruptive to the camp routine.

Packing Tips –

- **Please do not pack anything that is Irreplaceable**
 - Pack clothes for each day in a labeled Ziploc bag
 - One for each day at camp plus one additional change of clothes for an emergency.
 - Each bag should include:
 - ❑ 1 underwear
 - ❑ 1 pairs of socks
 - ❑ Shorts AM, pants PM
 - ❑ 1 shirt
 - Make sure your child can carry his/her bag(s), this is very helpful to cabin leaders for clean up.
 - Send a large trash bag for dirty clothes with your child's name on the bag.
 - All medication **MUST** be in the original bottle/packaging and clearly marked with the campers name on it. Please only send enough medication for the 4 days your camper is at camp.
 - Label **EVERYTHING** using a permanent marker (i.e.: each sock, shirt, pants, underwear, shoes, etc.).
 - Pack summer clothes for the day and warm clothes for the night (i.e.: pants, sweatshirts, and rain-coats)- **It does get cold.**
 - Please pack **close-toed walking shoes** and water shoes. **No sandals.**
- **Any clothing items that are left at camp will be donated, so please label everything****

	2 Towels (1 for water activities and 1 for shower)
	Large strong trash bag for dirty clothes—please label trash bag w/masking tape
	Flashlight with fresh batteries
	Chap stick or lip balm & sunscreen
	Water bottle with a carrying strap preferred
	Self-addressed & self-stamped envelopes, stationary or postcards
	Theme Night clothes/dinner attire (Funky Formal, Neon)

Monday July 8:

Pick up your camper at Cornerstone at 11:45am. We will bring your child down the mountain unless you let us know otherwise. If you prefer to pick up your child at camp, pick up time is 9:45 am Please note, we leave camp promptly at 10 am. Any child still at camp at this time will be transported back to the church and you will need to pick them up there.

Check-In

Check-in is **Friday July 5** between 3:00-4:00pm

The campers will be transported to Camp Cedar Crest by their parents.

Pick-Up

Pick-up is **Monday July 8** at Cornerstone at 11:45am. If you prefer to pick up your child at camp, pick up time is 9:45 am promptly.

To camp Cedar Crest

- Take the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10) **EAST** to Redlands,
- Go **NORTH** on **Junction 30** to the **330** which goes up the mountain to Running Springs where it will become Highway 18 to Big Bear.
- Go approximately 2.5 miles past Running Springs
- Turn **LEFT** onto Green Valley Lake Road
- Continue one mile to Camp Cedar Crest Road
- Take road ¼ mile to the parking lot

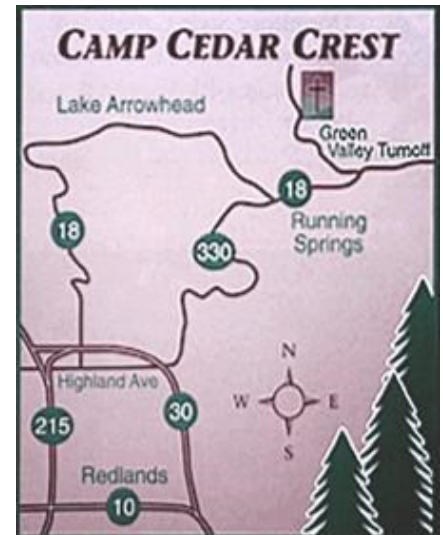
From Riverside

- Take the 91 Freeway **EAST** to the 215 **NORTH**.
- From there continue **NORTH** to Highway 30 to highway 330 -follow the Mountain Resort signs
- Go approximately 2.5 miles past Running Springs
- Turn **LEFT** onto Green Valley Lake Road
- Continue one mile to Camp Cedar Crest Road
- Take road ¼ mile to the parking lot

Head check Information

Please read the following policy about Head Lice

Our Policy on Head Lice is that **NO CAMPER** will be admitted to camp who is found to have head lice or nits. The camper **WILL BE SENT HOME.**

It is your responsibility as the parent/guardian to check your camper(s) head(s) before coming to camp.

Check your child(rens) head **2 weeks** prior, **1 week** prior and again **before** your departure to camp. If lice or nits are found, please take the necessary action to remove them. If any lice or nits are found BEFORE leaving camp, the camper(s) MUST be treated at home.

Upon arrival, all campers will go through a health check. If any signs of lice or nits are presented, they will be sent home. No treatment will be rendered up at camp.
